Call to Order

Student Council Report – no council present

- Middle year's elections will be held October 1, with speeches to be held at rewards day
- Senior year's elections nominations ended September 21. Will see if there will be a vote or acclamation.
- An invitation to attend the Home & School meetings will be extended to the junior and senior councils after they are formed

Administration Report – Jeff Latimer

- The school is feeling much closer to normal
- Grade 6's are in a cohort
- Grade 7-12 are in one cohort, which allows the kids in all the classrooms, access to lockers, gym and canteen
- Enrollment is currently at 365 students

- Intramurals and extra-curricular activities have started
- All school staff and coaches are required to be fully vaccinated or be tested 3 times a week
- At present, MHSAA (Manitoba High Schools Athletic Association) is not denying kids from sports based on vaccination status
- School visitors must be fully vaccinated or proof of a negative test from within the past 72 hours
- Parent/student/teacher meetings will not require parents to be vaccinated

Grade Representative Reports/ Questions

- Grade 7-12 awards ceremony will be live streamed on Tuesday, September 28.
- Noted that the video quality from the graduation ceremony in June was excellent

- Discussion as to what format to have Home & School meetings this year. Mary suggested a more inclusive combination of in-house (which would require attendees be vaccinated) and virtual setup for those who would prefer to participate from home
